#### Guided Questions (answer each thoroughly, required):

- 1. Describe the important characteristics of domestic post-war America.
  - a. Domestic post-war America can be characterized by a few things. Firstly, the life of veterans after they came back from fighting in the war. The GI bill, also known as the Servicemen's Readiustment Act of 1944, funded veterans' higher education programs so that they could study without having to worry about the financial end of it. This resulted in a comfortable life for these veterans after they returned home, and allowed them to pursue their post-service ambitions. Secondly, there was a baby boom that occurred. All the men that were out for war came back, which led to an exponential increase in babies born. Thirdly, there was substantial suburban growth. William J. Levitt created a movement that mass-produced low-priced family homes on Long Island, New York. He was able to do so because of the low interest rates on mortgages; this was highly attractive to families, and even those that weren't very wealthy were able to move to the suburbs. Lastly, the rise of the sunbelt. Many Americans wished to live in areas that had warmer climates, lower taxes, and economic opportunities in defense-related industries. The military spending during the Cold War helped fund this shift, which also eventually led to a political shift.
- How do organizations like the United Nations and NATO represent a shift in American foreign policy from the 1920's and 30's?
  - a. Prior to Truman's presidency, America was very isolationist and was against partnering with other countries for large-scale operations. However, Truman caused a shift in this thinking; it was already broken because of Roosevelt insisting that America should intervene in WWII, but Truman took it a step further by creating a major alliance between the US and European countries. Once people saw that doing so was actually a beneficial move that allowed for better regulation of first the Soviet Union, and then other issues later, Americans were much more willing to partake in international affairs.
- 3. Which Cold War policy do you believe had a bigger impact on keeping Western Europe capitalistic and democratic, the Marshall Plan or Truman Doctrine? Why?
  - a. I think that the Marshall Plan was more effective at promoting democracy in Western Europe. The Truman Doctrine was the first step that the US took to start their interventionist policies, so it was not as large scale as the Marshall Plan (the Doctrine only covered Greece and Turkey with a much smaller amount of money, while the Marshall Plan was meant for the entire of Western Europe and was much more money). The Marshall Plan also covered not just the governments of those countries but also prompted social relief. The people in those countries were deeply struggling after the war, and the money that the Marshall Plan provided led to the countries being able to sustain themselves again. The
