

Chapter 11: Introduction to Genetics

State Standards

Central Concept: Genes allow for the storage and transmission of genetic information. There are a set of instructions encoded in the nucleotide sequence of each organism. Genes code for the specific sequences of amino acids that comprise the proteins characteristic to that organism.

- 3.1 Describe the basic structure (double helix, sugar-phosphate backbone, linked by complementary nucleotide pairs) of DNA, and describe its function in genetic inheritance.
- 3.2 Explain how mutations in the DNA sequence of a gene may or may not result in phenotypic change in an organism. Explain how mutations in gametes may result in phenotypic changes in offspring.
- 3.4 Distinguish among observed inheritance patterns caused by several types of genetic traits (dominant, recessive, co-dominant, sex-linked, polygenic, incomplete dominance, multiple alleles).
- 3.5 Describe how Mendel's laws of segregation and independent assortment can be observed through patterns of inheritance (e.g., dihybrid crosses).
- 3.6 Use a Punnett Square to determine the probabilities for genotype and phenotype combinations in monohybrid crosses.
