Pathophysiology

Bipolar disorder is a mental health condition that causes extreme mood swings that include emotional highs (mania or hypomania) and lows (depression).

Risk Factors

- **Genetic:** immediate family member
- **Physiological:** neurotransmitters imbalance
- **Environmental:** increase stress trigger mania and depression

Sign & Symptoms

- Heightened, grandiose, or agitated mood
- attention seeking
- poor judgement
- sleeplessness or restlessness
- rapid speech
- flight of ideas
- reduced ability to filter out external stimuli; easily distracted
- increased level of energy
- perform high risk activities

Potential Complications

- substance abuse
- suicidal ideation or attempts
- financial problems
- damaged relationship
- poor work or school performance

Nursing Diagnosis

- **Risk for injury** as evidenced by impaired judgement that could lead to engaging in dangerous activity.
- **Risk for violence: self-directed or other directed** as evidenced by delusional thinking and hallucinations.
- **Impaired social interaction** related to disturbed thought process as evidenced by inability to develop satisfying relationships.
- **total self care deficit** related to inability to concentrate on one thing at a time as evidenced by observations of inability to perform ADLs task independently.

Nursing Intervention

- maintaining a safe environment
- providing therapeutic communication.
- limiting environmental stimulation
- providing rest periods
- monitor ADLs functioning and nutritional diet
- promoting appropriate behaviors
- managing medications

Evaluation

- client is able to differentiate between reality and unrealistic events/situations
- client is able to recognize thoughts that are not based in reality and stop their progression
- client is able to gain or maintained weight during hospitalization
- client will not act perform self harm activities or harm others
- client is no longer exhibiting signs of physical agitation

Treatment

- Mood stabilizers: Lithium, anticonvulsants (valproic)
- Antipsychotics: risperidone, chlorpromazine, olanzapine
- Antidepressants: SSRIs; fluoxetine
- ECT, CBT, Family and Group therapy

Patient Education

- medication adherence
- sign/symptoms of medication adverse effect
- follow up w/ case management
- encourage family/group therapy
- importance of regular ADL pattern
