These ulcers last on average 12 to 13 months are recurring in up to 60% to 70% of patients and can lead to loss of function poor quality of life and ill health As the population ages chronic wounds are becoming more prevalent more difficult to treat and care for chronic wounds has been reported to cost 2% to 3% percent of the healthcare budgets in developed countries.
