Take time to listen to your child.

Whenever your child is upset, you will need to use active listening to understand your child better and acknowledging that you are hearing what your child has to say. It can also help calm a situation and prevent a tantrum before it starts.



Let your child know when you think she has done something good. Praising your child is important in order to encourage good behavior. It can also be helpful to let your child overhear you praising him while talking to a relative or a friend. If the praise is sincere and honest, it can reinforce good behavior.



Read with your children. Reading helps strengthen your child's vocabulary, knowledge, and understanding of the world. It also creates opportunities for you and your child to spend time enjoying each other's company. It's never too early to begin reading to your child, and no book is too short.



Make time to laugh and be silly. A lot of parenting responsibilities are about taking care of your kids, keeping them well-fed and looking out for their well-being. Taking time to just talk to your kids to have fun with them shows how much you care about them and how much you want to be with them.



Avoid distracted parenting. When talking to your child, make sure to focus on talking to your child instead of doing something else while talking. It helps you focus and it makes your child understand that the conversation that you're having is a top priority.
