 - All compounds are molecules, but not all molecules are compounds.
 - b. Molecules are made up of any two or more atoms bonded together, but Compounds are made up of two or more different atoms bonded together.
- What is a valence electron?
 - a. Valence Electrons are Electrons located in the outermost Energy Shell of an atom. Since they are the farthest from the Nucleus, they can participate in bonds and reactions, therefore Valence Electrons determine an atom's reactivity, electronegativity, and the number of bonds it can form.
- Describe a covalent chemical bond, and what holds the two atoms together.
 - a. A Covalent Bond is formed through the equal sharing of valence Electrons in two atoms, with the sharing process enabling each atom to fill its outer valence electrons.
- Differentiate between a polar and non-polar covalent bond.
 - a. A Polar Covalent Band results if the Electronegativity difference from a band is between 0.5-1.6, meaning one end of the band is partly negative while the other is partly positive.
 - b. A Non-Polar Covalent Bond results if the Electronegativity difference from a bond is between 0.2-0.5.
- 12. What is a Hydrogen Bond, and what holds the two atoms together?
 - a. A Hydrogen B and occurs only with Polar Molecules, as the partial opposite charges of the molecules will attract one another, usually placing a Hydrogen atom as the bridge between the molecules.
- What is an ionic bond, and what holds the two atoms together.
 - a. An lonic Bond is a bond that is formed from the transfer of Electrons from one atom to another, therefore making one element have more Electrons that Protons and the other have fewer Electrons than Protons.
 - Essentially, the more Electronegative atom strips Electrons from another atom to complete its outer-most valence shell.
