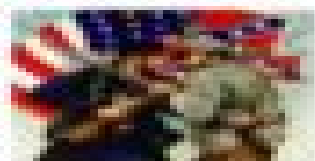
The Civil War lasted from April 12th 1861 - April 9th 1865.
