

## HEEL, LENS, AND HEEL

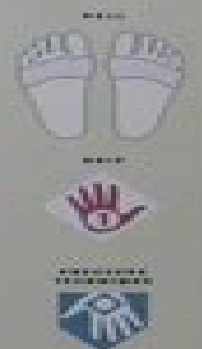

1 Using grip 1 (see page 242), start working on the heel area just below the "heel" of the shoe, over and over reflexive (see page 244). Support the foot from the inside using the standard support grip (see page 242) with all four fingers and the thumb on the top of the foot. The first of your working hand provides additional support on the side of the foot.



2 You can work moving from left to right, or moving from right to left. You will need to change your supporting hand and your working hand accordingly. In these photographs the left hand is the working hand and the right hand is the supporting hand for working the right foot; this is reversed for working on the left foot.



3 You can also work using an up and down technique over this area from the diaphragm to the "heel." It is important to ensure that the entire area is covered.



4 The heel works down further than the lower end of the ball of the foot, which represents the diaphragm reflex.

5 The heel reflex is located in the heel reflex area of the left foot, just above the diaphragm line, which is situated on the side towards the thumb, not towards the phalangeal joint.

The heel reflex is located on the left foot only.
