OBJECTIVES:

- a) Define electric flux
- b) Define Gauss' Law
- c) Apply Gauss' Law to various symmetric distributions

GLOSSARY:

Electric Flux: Measures the amount of electric field normal to a certain cross-sectional area multiplied by the area.

Gauss' Law: Relates the electric field flux through a closed surface to the charge in the volume contained by the closed surface.

Electrostatic Equilibrium: The state in which electric charges are not in motion.

ELECTRIC FLUX: The 2-D surface integral $\Phi_{\bullet} = \int \vec{B} \cdot d\vec{A}$

The electric flux is the amount of electric field that crosses some area and that is

perpendicular to that area. The area vector $\vec{A} = |A|\hat{n}$, where \hat{n} is the unit normal vector perpendicular to the surface Electric flux depends on three things:

- · The strength of the electric field
- · The size of the area the electric field is passing through
- The orientation between the field and the area

Gauss' Law:
$$\oint \vec{E} \cdot d\vec{A} = \frac{q_n}{\epsilon_n} (= \Phi_n)$$

This is an integral over a closed surface. [Remember, flux out of a closed surface is positive while flux into a closed surface is negative.]

This equation works for all cases, but it is only manageable under certain conditions. We can simplify the integral by creating a surface where each facet of the surface has one of the following conditions:
