DRAGON GENETICS

In this activity, you will use genetic information to create a dragon. You will use your knowledge of genetics to determine the genotype and phenotype for each of the 16 traits in your baby dragon from the chromosomes of the dragon egg you receive. You will also construct a picture of your baby dragon.

Materials Needed:

- I dragon egg containing the chromosomes for both parents
- Dragon black line drawing
- Colored pencils

Procedure:

- Obtain a dragon egg, which contains the chromosomes from the parents of your dragon.
- 2. Remove all the chromosomes from your egg. Chromosomes from the mother are pink and from the father are blue. Line up the matching chromosomes. The chromosome number is located at the bottom center of each chromosome. The number of the egg is at the top center, record this number on your data sheet. The X chromosomes are rectangular and the Y chromosomes are triangular.
- Using the key to dragon traits, determine your baby's genotype and phenotype for all of the traits listed on the chromosomes. Record this information in the proper spaces on the data table.
- Refer to the phenotypes you listed on the data table. For each phenotype listed, trace the corresponding
 dragon body part found on the black line drawing. Be sure to color your baby dragon's features with the
 appropriate colors, according to the phenotypes you have listed.
- Answer the questions on the back of your data table.
- Staple your baby dragon to your data table and turn it in. Be sure to turn in your dragon egg by the end of the period.
