SECTION 1. THE CELL CYCLE

Cell Cycle: (1) Gap1 (G_1): cells grow, carry out normal functions, and copy their organelles. (2) Synthesis (S): cells replicate DNA. (3) Gap 2 (G_2): cells go through additional growth. (4) Mitosis (M): cells undergo cell division, which involves both the processes of mitosis and cytokinesis.

8. Answers will vary. Sample answer: Cell size is limited because all substances must cross the membrane. Enough material needs to enter and exit to keep the cell alive. Since volume tends to increase faster than surface area (in a sphere or cube), the volume could quickly become too large compared to the area available for exchange. In a similar way, people in a very large theater that holds thousands might not be able to exit quickly for an emergency. People in a smaller theater that seats fewer people could probably exit more quickly.
