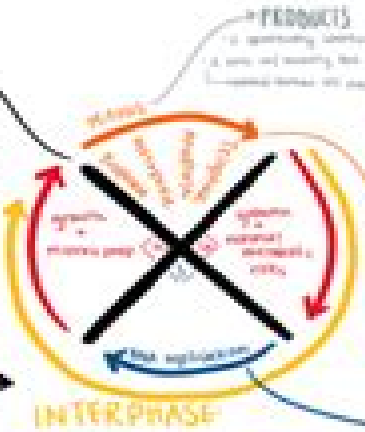
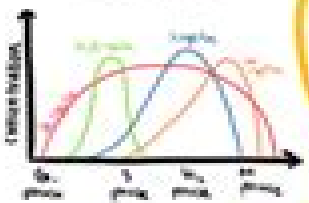


**Checklist control phases in cell cycle:**

- which release, allow to proliferate, what is, when passing, triggering activation of other proteins



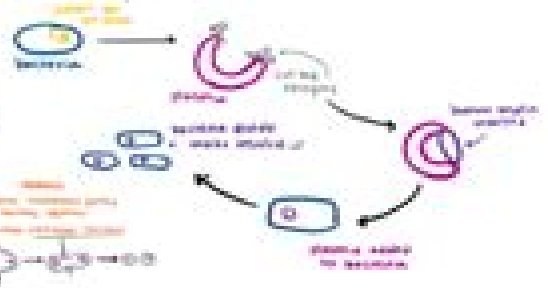

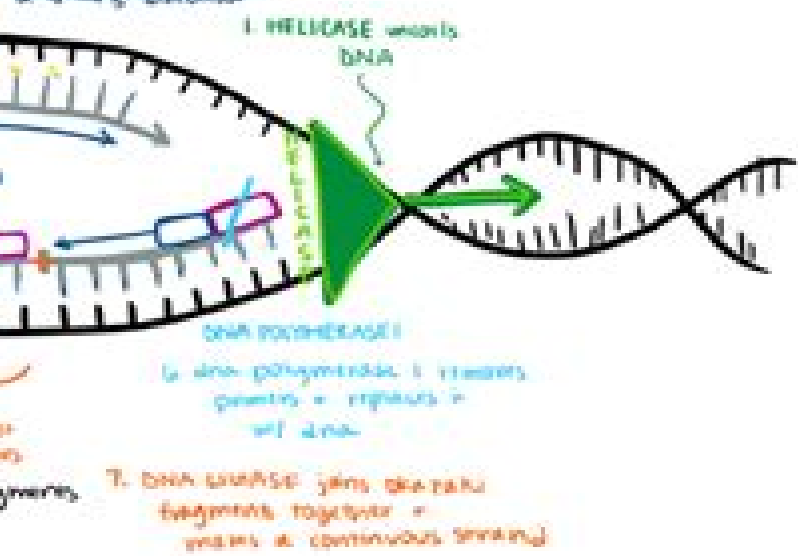
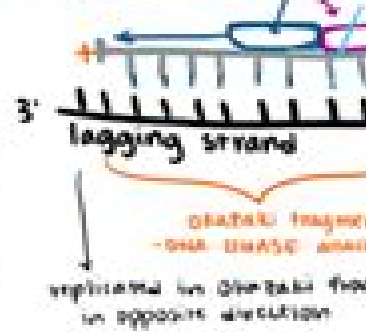
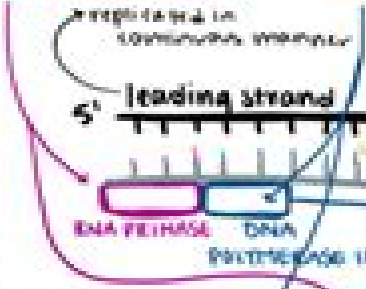
### 1. RNA PRIMASE
