Charting:

As these charts become available students will be encouraged to jot post-its that can be added to them. Remind students that they are expected to jot if they are waiting for others to finish reading the assigned section.

1. Themes: Introduce Pre-reading

Have themes chart available: Addiction, trouble, getting in over your head, snowball effect. Ask the group to try to explain what these themes could mean. Have students post-it events that support these themes throughout the book. Place them on the chart as appropriate.

2. Figurative Language: Introduce chapter 5

Chart similes, hyperboles, metaphors, and personification (use specifically in 5 although students can add to it during any chapter)

3. Types of Conflict: Introduce chapter 6
