- 5. Lines 74-78: What does the kenning "shadow of death" contribute to the characterization of Grendel?
- 6. Lines 109–124: Which details tell you about Beowulf? What conclusions about the traits most valued by the Anglo-Saxons can be drawn from this description?
- Lines 127–133: Why does Wulfgar request that the Geats leave their weapons outside the hall?
