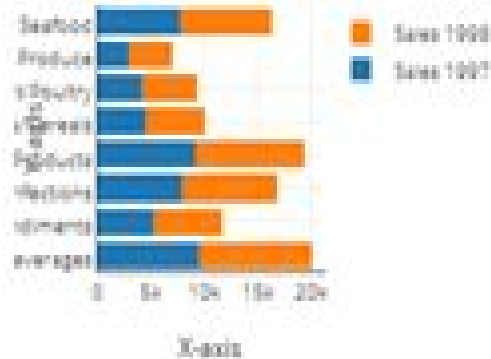

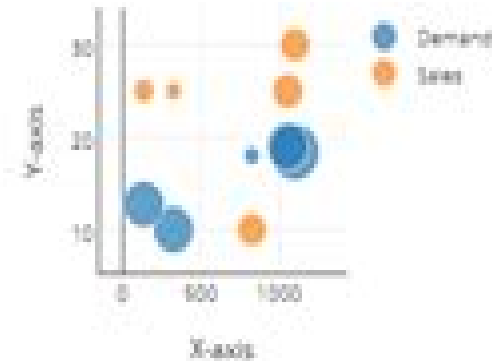

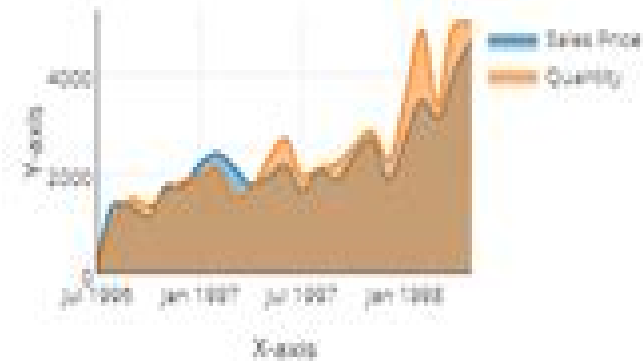
Bubble Chart
