Research Design

A qualitative study methodology was used to verify the theoretical research on all the women who had been sexually assaulted. Keith Punch defines qualitative design as "empirical analysis in which the analysis is not in the form of descriptive statistics".

It entails the systematic gathering and analysis of a wide range of analytical materials – case study, personal experience, introspective, life story, interview, anecdotal, historical, interactional, and visual texts – that illustrate routine and troublesome moments and meanings in people's lives. Denzin and Lincoln (Denzin and Lincoln, 2005:2)

Researchers who are using this method would like to gather more facts to get a more comprehensive idea of conflicts, instances, or occurrences (Arora and Stoner 2009).

This is often associated with case studies, in which the research was conducted solely on the basis of interpretation or experience with no outside impact.

In this study, a case study design has been used.

A qualitative case study is a research method that aids in the analysis of a phenomenon within a specific context using a variety of data sources and a variety of lenses in order to expose multiple aspects of the phenomenon (Baxter & Jack, 2008).

This design was applied since it's only focused on Women's who had been Sexually Harassed. In contrast to descriptive analysis, qualitative research builds an in-depth, contextual comprehension of the case by drawing on various data sources (Yin, 2003).

In addition, researchers used a case study to conduct an investigation into the effect of sexual harassment on women.

operates under the assumption that the length of the next CPU burst of each of the processes in ready queue is known CPU scheduling 2013 The SJF algorithm can be used in both pre emptive and non preemptive methods The algorithm can be preemptive or not Shortest Job First with preemption uses priority measure to determine the next process to be given the CPU The processes will be having different CPU bursts and different priority levels allocated to them The process with the least priority magnitude is always picked next A process already allocated the processor can be preempted the CPU and allocation done to another process with higher priority when such a process arrives in the queue SJF with non preemptive operates in the normal procedure whereby the job with the least CPU burst in the waiting queue is always picked next for allocation of the CPU and the rest of the processes have to wait no matter their urgency Based on the introduction above it is essential to use the right CPU scheduling strategy to help us achieve
