When we compare the great diversity of organisms that lives today we find that they are all made of the same core building blocks: nucleic acids, proteins, lipids, and carbohydrates.

3. Describe the meaning of each of the following terms with regard to the structure of DNA.

- Polymer** – DNA is made of repeating units of the nucleotides A, T, C, and G.
- Complementary base pairing** – the two strands of DNA are linked by specific hydrogen bond-mediated base pairing between the nucleotides A-T and C-G.
- Directionality** – the two strands of DNA have antiparallel orientation where one strand is directed 3' to 5' and the other 5' to 3'.
- Genome** – the complete sequence of nucleotides comprising an organism's DNA.
- Gene** – a region of DNA that controls a discrete, hereditary characteristic. Commonly it specifies the production of one functional product.
- Chromosome** – a single DNA molecule packaged into a functional unit.
