- Everything psychological is also biological.
- The human brain constantly changes and adjusts to new experiences.

Plasticity

The brain's ability to change by reorganizing after damage or building new pathways based on experience.

Parts of a Neuron

- Dendrites (Receive Messages)
- Axon (Passes messages away from the cell body to other neurons, muscles, or glands)
- Myelin Sheath (Covers the Axon of some neurons and helps speed neural impulses)
- Neural Impulse (Action potential; electrical signal traveling down the axon)
- Cell Body (The Cell's life support center)
- Terminal branches of Axon

Neuron

A nerve cell that is the basic building block of the nervous system.

- Contains dendrites that listen and axons that speak.

Action Potential

A nerve impulse

- A brief electrical charge that travels down an Axon

Glial Cells (Glia)

Cells in the nervous system that support, nourish, and protect neurons

- Play a vital role in learning, thinking and memory.
- Provide nutrients and myelin.
