Gastrointestinal Tract-a series of hollow organs through which food passes as it is ingested, digested
and absorbed, also called the digestive tract or alimentary canal

 Accessory Organs-assist in digestion, not part of the digestive tract, includes: teeth, tongue, salivary glands, liver, gallbladder, and pancreas

BASIC DIGESTIVE FUNCTIONS

1. Ingestion-delivery of food into digestive system via the mouth (normally)


 Secretion-endocrine and exocrine glands secrete substances to aid in digestive process (includes, mucus, enzymes, acids and hormones)

 Propulsion the movement of a substance through a hollow organ vis peristaltic contractions of smooth muscle layers and aided by secreted mucus.

4. Digestion-the process of breaking down a substance into smaller subunits,

Two Kinds: Mechanical-physically break food down into smaller pieces by chewing and movement Chemical-enzyme catalyzes reactions that break chemical bonds within particles

Absorption the transportation of a substance across an epithelial lining into the bloodstream or lymph
 Defection elimination of undigestible materials and a way for the body to eliminate metabolic waste (specialized form of propulsion)
