

13.3 – Cold War Conflicts 496-501

Guiding Questions: What common factor triggered the “hot” wars in Asia during the Cold War, and how did nuclear weapons influence political relations during the Cold War?

1. What were the two superpowers who emerged after WWII?

The two superpowers that emerged after WWII were the United States and the Soviet Union.

Superpower - a state with a dominant position characterized by its extensive ability to exert influence or project power on a global scale.

2. What were **Proxy Wars**? Why did the United States and the Soviet Union not want to fight each other directly?

A proxy war occurs when two powers in conflict use substitutes instead of fighting each other directly. Armed with nuclear arsenals, neither the U.S. nor the Soviet Union wanted to fight each other directly.

3. What are **SEATO** and **CENTO**? Why were they formed by the United States?

The Southeast Asia Treaty Organization (SEATO) was made to stem communist aggression in the East. The Central Treaty Organization (CENTO) was meant to prevent Soviet expansion into the Middle East.

4. In addition to wars in Korea and Vietnam, what other areas does the text list as **proxy conflict points**?

In addition, a Cold War proxy conflict almost turned into a major nuclear war over the small island of Cuba, Congo and Chile.

“hot” war - as opposed to a “cold” war, a hot war is a conflict with actual armed fighting.

5. How was Korea divided along the **38th parallel** after 1945? What side was Communist and what side was anti-Communist?

In August of 1945, the Soviet Union and the United States agreed to divide Korea into two zones of the 38th Parallel. The plan was to hold elections after WWII to reunify Korea. As America-Soviet relations grew worse, however, two separate governments emerged in Korea, Communists in North and Anti-Communists in South.

parallel - a line on the globe that marks an area north or south of the equator. For example, the US-Canada border sits mostly on the 49th parallel.

6. When the Communist North Koreans invaded anti-communist South Korea in June, 1950, who supported the North Koreans?

President Harry S Truman of the United States, seeing this as another example of Communist aggression and expansion, gained the approval of the United Nations and sent US troops to repel the invaders.

7. How did President Harry Truman respond to the communist invasion of South Korea? Who gave approval of this response?

President Harry S. Truman committed United States air, ground, and naval forces to the combined United Nations forces assisting the Republic of Korea in its defense.
