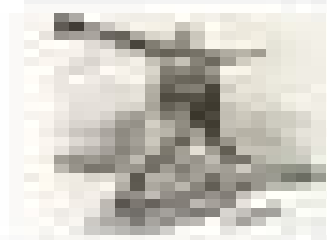


Modern Imperialism
