 - The basic difference between them is that **stimulants** speed up the workings of this system while **depressants** slow it down. Stimulants galvanise the CNS in a way that dramatically increases energy and therefore activity.
 - **Stimulants:** **caffeine**
 - **Depressants:** **Alcohol**
