

a dead end These points below are in my opinion the most important basic rules to succeed It is very important to have a strategy on methodology surface layout and surface construction Always try to build the surfaces to allow easy modification Keep the surfaces as simple as possible Always try to build to an intersection By following these basic rules you have come a long way to succeeding in your modeling Good luck
