OVERVIEW

This chapter provides a backdrop to the entire book. The end of the Cold War is usually seen as the beginning of the contemporary crain world politics which is the subject matter of this book. It concludes with an assessment of India's role in NAM and asks how successful the policy of nonalignment has been in protecting India's interests.
