15.1 Overview of the Cardiovascular System

 The ____pulmonary____ circuit picks up oxygen from the lungs and the systemic_____ circuit delivers oxygen to the body's cells.

- Pulmonary circuit: Transports oxygen poor blood from heart to lungs and back to the heart.
- Systemic circuit: Transports oxygen-rich blood from the heart to all body cells
- · Veins: carry blood towards the heart
- · Arteries: carry blood away from the heart

15.2 The Heart

 The heart is located ___medial____ to the lungs, ___anterior____ to the vertebral column, and ___posterior____ to the sternum.

- The heart is a hollow cone shaped, muscular pump within the mediastinum, it rests on the diaphragm.
- Its apex extends to the fifth intercostal space.
- Function of heart: supplying oxygen and nutrients to tissues, removes carbon dioxide.

3. Compare the layers of the pericardium and the heart wall.

- Pericardium: covering of the heart and large blood vessels. Consists of 2 layers
 - 1. Fibrous pericardium: outer tough layer of connective tissue
 - 2. Serous pericardium:delicate double layer
 - Parietal pericardium: Covers the inner layer surface of the fibrous pericardium.
 - Visceral pericardium (epicardium): inner layer directly covers the heart, visceral layer folds back and becomes the parietal pericardium.
 - Pericardial cavity: Space between visceral and parietal pericardium layers filled with serous fluid to reduce friction.
