ABSTRACT

The global demand for organic food products is growing at a very rapid rate in the present scenario. Two reasons are responsible for this; one is the environmentalists concerns regarding harmful effect of increasing use of chemicals in farming, the consumers are getting conscious and selective about edible products. Second reason is raising concern of health issues and food safety; many consumers have turned their site to organic products. This increasing awareness has caused shifts in consumers' tastes and preferences which have led to the domestic as well as global rise in demand for organic products. The adoption of organic production and processing is highly determined by market demand. Therefore, this is reflected in consumers' perceptions and attitudes towards organic products. This research draws on a survey of 190 respondents. Results indicated that the main reasons for purchasing organic food products are an expectation of a healthier and environmentally friendly means of production. Organic buyers tend to be Adults and educated than those who do not buy them. In addition, consumers' trust in the authenticity of the goods and price are also issues. However, the main barrier to increase the market share of organic food products is the lack of trust, high price and not availability of the products. The suppliers of organic food products should try to increase the availability of organic products in Bangalore through tie ups with various organized retailers in Bangalore.

1. INTRODUCTION

Food consumption patterns are changing as a result of health and environmental issues in the world. Interest in organically produced food is increasing throughout the world. Global demand for organic products remains robust, with sales increasing by over five billion US dollars a year (Willer, Yussefi-Menzler, and Sorensen 2009).

The global demand for organic food products is growing at a very rapid rate. Ever since the environmentalists raised their concern regarding harmful effect of increasing use of chemicals in farming, the consumers are getting conscious and selective about edible products. This increasing awareness has caused shifts in consumers' tastes and preferences which have led to the domestic as well as global rise in demand for organic products. The organic food industry in the world is worth US \$ 35 billion with a growth rate of 15 percent with most of the growth concentrated mainly in U.S.A, U.K. and Japan (Willer, 2004). To supplement this demand, farmers have taken to organic farming for getting price premiums which resulted in around 3.5 million hectare land across the globe under organic farming. In India, the farmers have followed the path for organic food production, but the share of India in the world organic market is less than one percent. In order to boost trade in Indian agricultural products and capture significant share in global market, it is an imperative that India focuses on organic products which give it competitive edge in global market, namely organic cotton, spices, essential oils, medicinal and aromatic plants and fresh fruits and vegetables. Organic farming in irrigated and intensive farming areas holds another kind of promise,

a source of sustainable and value added commercial farming.

Consumers who were concern on the environment can be inferred to be sensitive to information regarding to not only the environment itself but also on products, brands and activities that might affect it (Minton and Rose 1997). The most convincing evidence supporting the growth of ecologically favorable consumer behavior was the increasing number of individuals who were willing to pay more for environmentally friendly products (Laroche, et. al., 2001).

2. ORGANIC AGRICULTURE IN INDIA

Organic Agriculture is not a new concept to India. At the beginning of the 19th century, Sir Albert Howard, one of the most important pioneers of organic farming, worked in India for many years, studying soil-plant interactions and developing composting methods. In doing so, he capitalized substantially on India's highly sophisticated traditional agricultural systems, which had long applied many of the principles of organic farming (e.g. crop rotations with legumes, mixed cropping, botanical pesticides etc.).

Though the introduction of Green Revolution agricultural technology in the 1960s reached the main production areas of the country, there were still certain areas (especially mountain areas) and communities (especially certain tribes) that did not adopt the use of agro-chemicals. Therefore, some areas can be classified as 'organic by default', though their significance and extent has been rather overemphasized in recent statements made by some
