Approach to development- when talking about development issues, two general approaches are identified

- I. Fight against poverty -focussing on issues of widespread poverty hunger and slavery. In developing countries and on the line of the question of what can be done to alleviate poverty and slavery
- II. The analysis of long term economic and social development -involves comparative studies on development in various countries, regions or periods in time. In order to understand factors that have long term effects on development. In other words analysing issues cumulatively to see or placed their impact on development in the long run. And to explain differences between regions (Africa/Europe) and countries (India/China)

NB - A good approach to development is one that takes into account of two mechanism above

The first one gives us a chance to mitigate poverty by alleviating suffering while the second one gives us the wider or bigger picture from which we can make or amend policy to be able to guidez toward achieving long-term results in development

Conceptualizing Development

- Development as economic growth-made down
- Development as poverty reduction-aimr to melt down effect of cdp increased but did not necessary translate to go away of life of the ordinary man. Development is more than economic growth and changes in economic structure. Dodley seers argued that for development to be seen to be taking place,then there should be a decline in poverty and malnutrition, decline in economic inequality and decline in unemployment. Since sueus is on poverty reduction, economic growth should be pro-poor
- Development as social welfare - its argued that development is more than economic dimensions of development stake. Since there can be growth in human incomef but have high levels of illetracy,low health indices,low life expectancy and acute malnutrition. This brought in the notion of social indicators of development that mainly included things like life expectancy literacy, infant mortality , quality of education,healthcare, security, nutrition. In this case development is conceived as social welfare of the people. Hpw people are fairing on is the social indicators discussed above
- Development as modernisation - modernisation is the transition from traditional way to social economic and political life to the western way of life. Int this case one looks at the extends to which society has moved away from traditional life to the so called modern life. (Traditional considered to be primitive and that we should embrace the modern progressive way of life)
