Chromosomes: A **genome** is the full set of chromosomes contained in an organism's cells. (LO 1)

Chromosomes: are made of DNA, organized linearly in the way that the following cell.

A **karyotype** is a picture that shows the complete set of chromosomes of an organism, often being **metaphase**.

They are grouped in pairs and ordered by pairs of decreasing size and by sex chromosomes. **Chromosomes**.

The sex cell (haploid) contains half of the chromosomes of the body cells (diploid).

It appears human diploid and haploid chromosomes in 23 pairs.

There are 22 pairs of autosomes (the chromosomes not involved in sex: 22 = Groups and X/Y = sex). The sex chromosomes are not paired (X).
