Artificial selection- selective breeding of plants and animals to promote the occurrence of desirable traits in offspring

Natural selection (Definition & Purpose of Who wants to live a million years) Natural selection is the process whereby organisms better adapted to their environment tend to survive and produce more offspring. The purpose of who wants to live a million years was to test which species would best adapt to the environment they were put into and whichever one lived the longest was the best adapted/evolved species.

Four principles of natural selection- Individuals in a population show variations, variations can be inherited, organisms have more offspring that can survive on available resources, and Variations that increase reproductive success will have a greater chance of being passed on.

Evolution- the process by which different kinds of living organisms are thought to have developed and diversified from earlier forms during the history of the earth

The origin of species by means of natural selection (What was the book about?)- The book was about Darwin's theory of evolution and his findings that supported his data
