An Urban Age and a Consumer Society

Farm's and Cities

- Progressives were individuals that hoped to bring significant change in American social and political life.
 Americans realized that they were not free.
- Progressive era- period of explosive economic growth, fueled by increasing industrial production, rise in population, and consumer marketplace expansion.
- Farms recovered from low points after the depression and entered the agricultural "golden age." More farm coods were needed in the crowing urban populations.
- The city was the focus of Progressive politics and a new mass-consumer society.
- Immigrants lived in poor conditions; tenements without electricity or toilets.
- More than ½ of the country's mining and manufacturing workers lived in poverty.

The Muckrakers

- Some believed the city was a place of greedy businessmen.
- Theodore Roosevelt defined muckraking as the use of journalistic skills to expose the underside of American life.
- Some Muckraking sparked outrage and led to the Pure Food and Drug Act and the Meat Inspection Act of 1906 after some publishers wrote about the truths of food production.

Immigration as a Global Process

- The new immigration from southern and eastern Europe reached its peak in the Progressive era.
- Progressive era immigration made a larger worldwide migration process. It was set in motion by industrial
 expansion and the decline of traditional acriculture.
- Uprooting the population was caused by many things.
 - Asia- Poverty, illiteracy, taxation, declining economics
 - Mexico-Political termoil
- Large numbers of Chinese, Medican, and Ralian migrants were bound to labor contracts.
- Most European immigrants entered through Ellis Island. It was the nation's main facility for processing immigrants. You were sent home if you were an anarchist, prostitute, or undesirable person. Also if you failed a medical exam.
- Japanese arrived in California and Hawaii. They entered through Angel Island in San Francisco Bay. It was
 the main entry point for immigrants from Asia.
- 1 million Medicans immigrated from 1900-1930. They entered through El Paso.
- By 1910, 1/7 of the population was foreign-born. The highest percentage in the country's history, Most of the immigrants were clustered in industrial cities.

The Immigrant Quest for freedom

- The new immigrants imagined the USA as a land of freedom.
- Many immigrants wanted to return home to purchase more land. Many Mexicans and Italians only remained temporarily in the country, and many Italians left in 1908.
- Immigrants endure low wages, long hours, and dangerous working conditions.

Consumer Freedom

- Large downtown department stores, chain stores in urban neighborhoods and retail mail-order houses for farmers and small-town residents were made available to consumers throughout the country during the Progressive era.
- Low wages and poverty limited the consumer economy.
- Leisure activities, such as amusement parks, dance halls, and theaters attracted large crowds of city dwellers.
