T lymphocytes have protein receptors in their cell surface membranes. These T cell receptors are very similar in structure to antibody molecules. Each type of T cell receptor binds specifically to one type of antigen. Fig. 1 shows part of a cell surface membrane of a T cell with an antigen bound to a T cell receptor.


