Basic Life Support (BLS)

Basic cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)






Safety

The rescuer, victim and bystanders must be in a safe position in order for BLS to proceed.



Check responsiveness

Does the victim respond to stimuli? Shake the victim by the shoulders and ask if the victim is awake.



Breathing

Open the airway by tilting the head backward and lifting the chin up. Does the person breathe? Look for respiratory signs for 10 seconds.



Alert emergency services

If the victim is not breathing, or breathing abnormally, alert the emergency services (911 in the US, 112 in Europe).



Find an AED

If possible, send a bystander to find an AED.



Initiate chest compressions and, if possible, ventilations

Perform chest compressions. If possible, provide ventilation.
