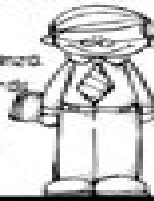
Poems

RL.5.1-2 can refer to parts of poems using terms stanza to describe how each successive part builds on earlier sections.

Stanza: Consists of two or more lines that form one section or division of the poem.

Line: A line is one line contained within the stanza.

Repetition: Lines or words that are repeated. Lines and words that are repeated show the reader that they are important!



Dramas

RL.5.1-2 can refer to parts of dramas using terms to describe how each successive part builds on earlier sections.

Scene:

This is the setting and the events that happen in the setting.

Narrator:

The person who tells what happens.

Stage Directions:

This tells an actor or actress where to go. It is usually in italics & in parenthesis.

Cast of Characters:

The actors & actresses.



Stories

RL.5.1-2 can refer to parts of stories using terms to describe how each successive part builds on earlier sections.

Chapter: A main division in a book. Chapters often have a number or title about that section.

Opening: The initial part that sets the stage.

Closing: The ending that wraps up, concludes and brings everything to a final point.
