- Use soft-tabs with a two space indent. Spaces are the only way to guarantee code renders the same in any person's environment.
- · Put spaces after | in property declarations.
- · Put spaces before (in rule declarations.
- Put line breaks between rulesets.
- When grouping selectors, keep individual selectors to a single line.
- Place closing braces of declaration blocks on a new line.
- · Each declaration should appear on its own line for more accurate error reporting.

Formatting

- Use hex color codes: #866 unless using rgha()
- Use // for comment blocks (instead of /* */).
- Avoid specifying units for zero values, e.g., surgis: e; instead of surgis: eps;
- Strive to limit use of shorthend declarations to instances where you must explicitly set all the available values.
