

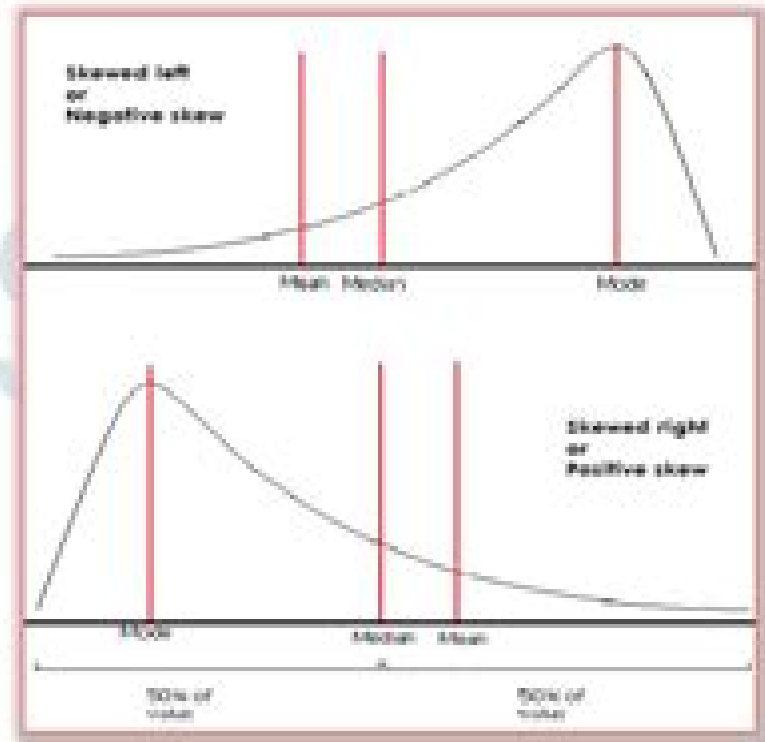
Percentiles & quartiles: Imagine a set of observations whose values are arranged in an ascending order. The value below which 5% of observations (i.e. 50 observations if the original set had 1000 individual values; 5 observations if the set contained 100 values) lay is called 5th percentile. The value below which 95% of observations (i.e. 950 observations if the original set had 1000 individual values; 95 observations if the set contained 100 values) lay is called 95th percentile. The value below which 50% of observations lay is called 50th percentile or median. Similarly, if instead of 1 in 100 divisions ('per-cent = 100'), one uses 1 in 4 divisions, one may get quartiles. 25% values lay below 1st quartile; 50% below 2nd quartile (median) and 75% below 3rd quartile. Statisticians often use the box-whisker plot in the context of quartiles.

✓ **Mode :**

- It is the most commonly occurring value in a distribution.
- It is a crude measure mostly used for nominal data (frequencies).
- It is also useful for ordinal data to understand the most common rating obtained on a Likert scale; but similar to the median, it ignores most of the available information.
- In bimodal distribution, two values occur equally frequently.

✓ **Skew:**

- In normal symmetric distribution, mean median and mode are equal. Distributions that are not normal are called **skewed distributions**.
- In **skewed distributions**, the extreme values will affect the mean to a larger degree than they affect median/mode. The mean will "chase the tail" of skewed distributions, whereas the mode will tend to stay home; median usually lies between mode and mean.
- In **positive skew**, higher extreme outliers are present, making the mean higher than median. Hence, the distribution curve shows longer tail on the right side.
- In **negative skew**, lower value outliers lead to mean being less than median and left tail being longer than right.
- Note that irrespective of the direction of a skew, the mode is always on the shorter side (outliers not as common as other values) and mean on the longer side.
