

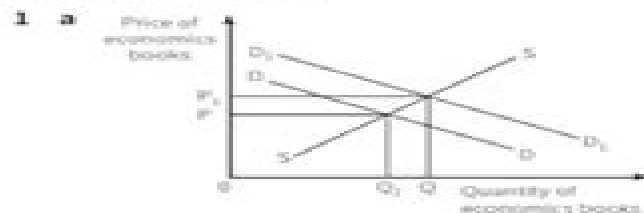

Suggested answers to individual and group activities

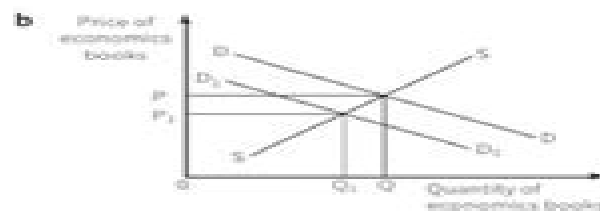
Group activities

- The price of agricultural products fluctuates more than the price of manufactured goods because agricultural products are affected by weather conditions, pests and diseases and because manufactured goods can be stored. A period of bad weather or the outbreak of a disease could cause a significant decrease in the supply of, for instance, wheat. Wheat is also perishable; if there is a bumper crop, it will all have to be sold. A large increase in supply could result in a significant fall in price. In contrast, producers of shoes do not have to sell all the shoes they produce if they think it will lead to a fall in price.

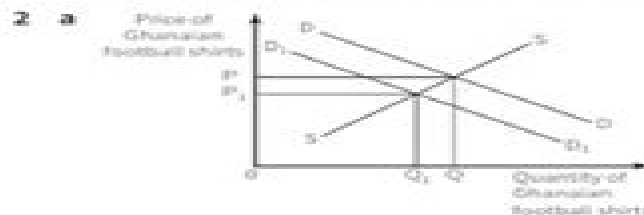
Individual activities
